Luke 11.2-4 (NIV)

“When you pray, say:

“Father,

hallowed be your name,  
your kingdom come.

Give us each day our daily bread.  
Forgive us our sins,  
for we also forgive everyone who sins  
against us.  
And lead us not into temptation.”

Matthew 6.13 (NIV11)

“And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.”

Psalm 91.9 (NirV)

The Lord is the one who keeps you  
safe.

So let the Most High God be like a  
home to you.



Psalm 91.4-5 (NirV)

He will cover you with his wings. Under the feathers of his wings you will find safety. He is faithful. He will keep you safe like a shield or a tower. You won't have to be afraid of the terrors that come during the night. You won't have to fear the arrows that come at you during the day.

being choosing to love him

Psalm 91.14 (NIV11)

“Because he loves me,” says the Lord,  
“I will rescue him;  
I will protect him, for he acknowledges  
my name.”

John 14.15 (NIV11)

“If you love me, keep my commands.”

We find Father's protection by  
trusting him

Psalm 91.2 (NIV11)

I will say of the Lord, “He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust.”

Psalm 91.14 (NirV)

The Lord says, “I will save the one who loves me. I will keep him safe, because he trusts in me.”

Proverbs 18.10 (NIV11)

The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.



2Corinthians 10.4-5 (NIV11)

The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds.

We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

1Peter 5.7 (NIV11)

Cast all your anxiety on him because  
he cares for you.

Philippians 4.6-7 (NIV11)

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Will we trust? Are we prepared to ask him? And then act on that trust and request?

1Corinthians 10.13 (NIV11)

You are tempted in the same way all other human beings are. God is faithful. He will not let you be tempted any more than you can take. But when you are tempted, God will give you a way out so that you can stand up under it.

James 4.7-8 (NIV11)

Submit yourselves, then, to God.  
Resist the devil, and he will flee from  
you. Come near to God and he will  
come near to you. Wash your hands,  
you sinners, and purify your hearts,  
you double-minded.
